I. NATIONAL TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION (STAGE – I) 2019

INFORMATION BROCHURE

A. Scheme:

NATIONAL TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION (STAGE-I, for the students studying in Class X in the UT of Puducherry)

The first stage National Talent Search (NTS) Written Examination (State Level) is conducted by the Directorate of School Education, Puducherry launched by the MHRD, New Delhi in order to identify the talented students and nurture them. Then, based on the merit list of this written examination 20 students [11-General, 1-EWS, 5-OBC and 3-S.C.origin] as per the quota allotted to the UT of Puducherry will be eligible to participate in the Second Stage written examination (National Level) conducted by the NCERT, New Delhi. The students selected in the Second Stage Written Examination (National Level) conducted by the NCERT, New Delhi will receive scholarship from the NCERT, New Delhi.

The Government of Puducherry awards ₹.5,000/- to the students selected in the State Level Examination and ₹.10,000/- to students selected in the National Level Examination as one time incentive.

B. Eligibility to Appear:

1. All students of Class X studying in recognized State / Central Government schools in U.T.of Puducherry (Govt. /Govt. Aided/Private Unaided schools) are eligible.
2. The National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS) awardees are also eligible.

C. How to apply for the Examination:

1. Students can apply for the exam by online and should take a print out of the application generated.
2. The user ID and password for the schools will be provided to the Department.
3. The Heads of Schools should submit the print outs of the applications of the students who have applied to the O/o the Joint Director, DSE, Puducherry.

D. Syllabus:

The whole portions of class IX and portions upto December of Class X in Mathematics, Science and Social Science subject of State Board Syllabus.

E. Exam Pattern:

This examination consists of two parts namely PART-I and PART-II. Separate question booklets will be provided for Part-I (Mental Ability Test) and Part-II (Scholastic Aptitude Test). All questions are to be answered.
